Trinity Café Receives Grant from Community Foundation of Tampa Bay
Funds will purchase protein-rich food for the homeless

TAMPA, Fla. – (May 6, 2010) – **Community Foundation of Tampa Bay**

(<http://www.cftampabay.org>) has awarded a grant to **Trinity Cafe** (<http://www.trinitycafe.org>)

for the purchase of protein-rich food to feed the homeless and hungry.

“Protein is the largest portion of the cost of each meal we prepare to feed the more than 200 guests who eat here daily,” says Cindy Davis, Trinity Café program director. “We are so grateful to the Community Foundation for their grant, which will purchase 625 pounds of protein and provide more than 1,200 meals.”

Most guests of Trinity Café consume only one meal each day, so a generous protein serving helps to provide the recommended daily requirement, fueling the body with energy and sustenance.
